How does art depart from its purpose?


1) STEP ONE: They glorify Him not as God.

2) STEP TWO: They worship creation.

3) STEP THREE: They worship themselves.

1 Samuel 18

- Praises David
- Ignores God
- Fills Saul with Jealousy
